

LBF-1 No servant can work for two employers. Either he will hate one and love the other, or hold to one and despise the other. You can't work for God and money. (Luke 16:13; Mt 6:24)

MATTHEW 6, LUKE 16

LBF-8 What should I do to have eternal life? Sell all that you have, and give it to the poor, and you'll have treasure in heaven. Then come and follow me. (Lk 18:18, 12:33, 14:33, 11:41)

LUKE 11, 12, 14, 18

KoH-5 Do not stop living together, the way some people have; but encourage one another, and especially as you see the return of Christ coming nearer. (Heb10:35)

HEBREWS 10

LBF-2 Don't work for the food that perishes, but for the food that lasts forever, which the Son of man will give to you; for he alone has God's seal on him. (John 6:27)

JOHN 6

KoH-9 Public meetings are not the time to eat Christ's meal. You have homes where you can do that. Do you want to embarrass non-believers, or bring shame on the church by implying that unbelievers are part of it? (I Cor 11:20-22)

I CORINTHIANS 11

KoH-6 They 'assembled' (lived) with the church for a whole year, and taught many people. And the disciples were called 'Christians' first there in Antioch. (Acts 11:26)

ACTS 11

LBF-9 Whoever does not forsake all that they own cannot be my disciple. (Lk 14:33)

LUKE 14

LBF-11 No soldier goes to war and pays his own wages. God feeds the cow that helps grind the grain, and he feeds preachers too. If we give you something spiritual, we are entitled to receive material things from you in return. (I Cor. 9:7-11)

I CORINTHIANS 9

KoH-7 When we were with you we always had this rule: If anyone refuses to work (in the commune) then they should not eat (in the commune). (II Thess 3:10)

II THESSALONIANS 3

LBF-4 Don't worry about what you will eat or drink or wear. Everyone tries to get those things. Your heavenly Father knows you need them; so seek his kingdom first and he will provide the rest. (Mt 6:31-33)

MATTHEW 6

KoH-4 They all lived together, and shared everything communally. They sold their belongings and gave to anyone who was in need. (Acts 2:44-45) They owned everything in common. And no one lacked anything, because those who had property sold it, and gave the proceeds to their leaders. (Acts 4:32-35)

ACTS 2, 4

KoH-8 He made apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, and teachers. Together they should be training the other saints to be ministers too. (Eph 4:11-12)

EPHESIANS 4

KoH-3 Don't you know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, which lives in you? (I Cor. 6:19; 3:16, II Cor 6:16)

I CORINTHIANS 3, 6

II CORINTHIANS 6

KoH-2 God does not live in temples made with hands. (Acts 7:48) God, who made the world and everything in it, does not live in a man-made temple, neither is worshipped with things we make, as though he needs anything. (Acts 17:24-25)

ACTS 7, 17

LBF-3 You remember that we worked night and day preaching the gospel to you, because we did not want to be accused by any of you of not having done our duty. (I Thess. 2:9)

I THESSALONIANS 2

LBF-6 The love of money is the root of all evil, and some have turned away from their faith because they coveted after it, bringing much sadness to their lives as a result. (I Tim 6:10)

I TIMOTHY 6

LBF-5 I'm not ashamed of the gospel because God's fairness is shown in it, as it is written, "Good people live by faith." (Rom 1:16-17) Good people live by faith, but if they turn back, I'll be displeased with them. (Heb 10:38) (Gal 3:11)

ROMANS 1, HEBREWS 10, GALATIANS 3,

KoH-10 He went everywhere preaching and showing the kingdom of heaven. The 12 were with him, as well as certain women, who gave him what they had. (Lk 8:2)

LUKE 8

LBF-7 Kill attitudes in yourself that aren't what God wants: lust, dishonesty, and greed which is the same as idolatry. (Col 3:5) (Eph 5:5)

COLOSSIANS 3 EPHE- SIANS 5

KoH-1 The kingdom of God cannot be seen physically, nor can you say, 'Look here it is!' or 'Look there it is!' because the kingdom of God is within you. (Lk 17:20-21)

LUKE 17

LBF-10 If anyone comes to me and does not hate his father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. (Lk 14:26)

LUKE 14

Jc-1 I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life. No one can come to the Father except by me. (Jn 14:6)

JOHN 14

Jc-9 Anyone who rejects me and my teachings has one that judges him. The words I have spoken will judge him in the last day. (Jn 12:48)

JOHN 12

Hs-4 God is Love; and anyone who lives in love, lives in God, and God lives in that person. (I Jn 4)

I JOHN 4

Jc-10 If you want to follow me, then deny yourself and take up your cross daily to do so. If you are ashamed of me and of my teachings, I will be ashamed of you. (Lk 9:23-26; Mk 8:38)

MARK 8, LUKE 9

Jc-8 Why do you call me 'Lord' but disobey my teachings? (Lk 6:46; 13:24-27) Not everyone who says 'Lord, Lord!' will enter the kingdom of heaven, only those who obey my Father. Many will say, 'We have done wonderful works in your name.' I'll say, 'I never knew you.' (Mt 7:21-23)

LUKE 6, 13, MATTHEW 7

Hs-5 If I speak in the languages of angels and do not have love, my 'tongues' are nothing but a lot of noise. (I Cor. 13:1)

I CORINTHIANS 13

Jc-3 You are built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, but Jesus Christ himself is the chief cornerstone. (Eph 2:20; I Pt 2:6)

EPHESIANS 2,
I PETER 2

Jc-2 If you hear my teachings and do them, you're like a wise person who builds on a rock. When storms come, the house will not fall. But if you hear my teachings and do not obey them, you're like a foolish person who built on sand. (Mt 7:24-27)

MATTHEW 7

Hs-6 This is how everyone will know that you are my disciples: They will see your love toward one another. (Jn 13:35)

JOHN 13

Jc-11 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. (Heb 13:8)

HEBREWS 13

Jc-4 The stone that the builders threw out has become the head cornerstone. Whoever falls on it will be broken, but if they wait for it to fall on them, it'll grind them to powder! (Lk 20:17-18; Mt 21:42-44)

LUKE 20, MATTHEW 21

Hs-7 You will know true prophets from false prophets in the same way you can tell a good tree from a bad tree: by their 'fruit'. (Mt 7:20)

MATTHEW 7

Jc-5 There is only one God, and only one mediator between God and the human race, and that is the man Jesus Christ. (I Tim 2:5)

I TIMOTHY 2

Hs-1 Everyone who asks, receives. If you know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him. (Lk 11:9-13)

LUKE 11

Hs-8 God has not given us the spirit of fear, but of power and of love, and of a sound mind. (II Tim 1:7)

II TIMOTHY 1

Jc-6 Let God be true and everyone else a liar, as it is written, 'You are right in all that you say, and you win every argument.' (Rom 3:4)

ROMANS 3

Hs-9 You'll receive strength when the Holy Spirit comes on you, so that you can witness for me: in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the farthest parts of the earth. (Acts 1:8)

ACTS 1

Hs-2 If anyone does not have the Holy Spirit, that person does not belong to God. (Rom 8:9)

ROMANS 8

Jc-7 Some have tried to pervert the gospel of Christ. But if I or an angel from heaven preach any other gospel than what I've already preached, let us be damned. (Gal 1:7-8)

GALATIANS 1

Hs-3 The fruit (result) of having God's spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, gentleness, honesty, faith, meekness, and self-control. There is no law that can stop you from having these things. (Gal 5:22-23)

GALATIANS 5

Hs-10 It is my Spirit that gives you life. My flesh is useless. My teach-ings are my Spirit, and they are the source of life. (Jn 6:63)

JOHN 6

Condemnation-3 If our hearts condemn us, God is greater than our hearts. (I Jn 3:20) Note: vv17-19 say if we share our wealth, we can 'persuade' our hearts (not to condemn us).

I JOHN 3

Discipline-1 Do what is right, acting in wisdom and not foolishly, so you can buy back some of the time that has been wasted on evil. (Eph 5:16) Be wise in your dealings with outsiders, using your time wisely. (Col 4:5)

EPHESIANS 5, COLOSSIANS 4

Discipline-4 Whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all to the glory of God. (I Cor 10:31) Whatever you do, in word or in action, do it in the name of Jesus. (Col 3:17)

I CORINTHIANS 10, COLOSSIANS 3

Discipline-7 Because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue you out of my mouth. (Rev 3:16)

REVELATION 3

Endtime-3 In that day, he that is in the field should not return back. Whoever seeks to save his life will lose it. Two will be in the field; one will be taken and the other left. (Lk 17:31-36)

LUKE 17

Endtime-8 The antichrist is given power to make war with the saints. (Rev 13:7) (Dan 7:21-25) He destroys the holy people. (Dan 8:24) When he has finished scattering the strength of the holy people, all these things will be finished. (Dan 12:7)

REV. 13, DAN. 7, 8, 12

Endtime-6 The 10 horns (or kings) on the Beast, will hate the Whore and make her desolate, and burn her with fire, and give their kingdom to the Beast. (Rev 17:16-17)

REVELATION 17

Condemnation-2 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and fair, to forgive our sins and wash away all of our wrong doings. (I Jn 1:9)

I JOHN 1

Condemnation-5 Who has bewitched you? Having started in the Spirit, are you now going to become perfect by following manmade rules? (Gal 3:1-3)

GALATIANS 3

Discipline-3 Be happy from now on. Never stop praying. Be thankful in every circumstance, because this is God's will for you. (I Thess 5:16-18)

I THESSALONIANS 5

Discipline-6 Anyone who is faithful in little things will also be faithful in big things. And those who are unfair in the smallest things will be unfair in the biggest things as well. (Lk 16:10)

LUKE 16

Endtime-2 After the tribulation... the sign of the Son of man will appear in hea-ven... They'll see him coming in the clouds... and he'll send his angels with the sound of a trumpet, to gather his chosen ones. (Mt 24:29-31)

MATTHEW 24

Endtime-7 I heard another voice from heaven saying, 'Come out of (the Whore) my people, so that you do not become a part of her sins and suffer part of her plagues.' (Rev 18:4)

REVELATION 18

Endtime-5 He (the antichrist) causes everyone to receive a mark on their hand or forehead, so that no one can buy or sell without the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. (Rev. 13:16-17)

REVELATION 13

Condemnation-1 There is no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who don't follow their selfish desires, but who follow his Spirit instead. (Rom 8:1)

ROMANS 8

Condemnation-4 This is real love: not how much we love God, but how much he loved us, by sending his Son to be the payment for our sins. (I Jn 4:10)

I JOHN 4

Discipline-2 Practice being quiet, and doing your own business, working with your hands as we instructed you to do. (I Thess 4:11)

I THESSALONIANS 4

Discipline-5 Study to please God and to be a worker who does not need to be ashamed, because you have learned to recognise the truth. (II Tim 2:15)

II TIMOTHY 2

Endtime-1 We'll all be changed instantly at the sound of the last trumpet. The trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised to life. (I Cor. 15:51)

I CORINTHIANS 15

Endtime-4 The 'woman' fled into the wilderness where she has a place prepared by God. There they will feed her for 1,260 days. (Rev. 12:6)

REVELATION 12

Endtime-9 From the order to rebuild Jerusalem to Christ is 7x7 and 62x7 (483 yrs). God keeps his promise for one (last) 7 year period. In the middle of it, he stops the sacrifices. (Dan 9:25-27) From the time the sacrifices are taken away, there are 1,290 days left. (Dan 12:11) The daily sacrifice and sin of desolation take 2,300 days.(Dan 8:13-14)

DANIEL 8, 9, 12

Grace/obedience-2 As the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also. (Jas 2:26)

JAMES 2

Grace/obedience-9 God wants you to be free, but you should not use your liberty as an excuse to be hateful. Rather, you have been freed to work as God's servants. (I Pt 2:15-16)

I PETER 2

Outreach-1 Go into all the world and preach the gospel to everyone. (Mk 16:15; Mt 28:19)

MARK 16, MATTHEW 28

Grace/obedience-3 We are born again, not by a physical seed, but by a spiritual seed, that is, by the word of God, which lasts forever. (I Pt 1:23)

I PETER 1

Grace/obedience-4 Don't deceive yourselves: if you sin, you don't know Christ. You can't be 'righteous' if your actions don't show it. Those who sin are of the devil, and Christ came to stop people from working for the devil. (I Jn 3:6-8)

I JOHN 3

Grace/obedience-12 Anyone who knows what they should do and still refuses to do it, to that person, such inaction is sin. (Jas 4:17)

JAMES 4

Grace/obedience-10 You have been called to be free; but do not use your liberty as an opportunity to be selfish. Instead, use it as an opportunity to serve others in love. (Gal 5:13)

GALATIANS 5

Outreach-6 I've made you a watchman. So if I tell you to warn the people and you don't, they'll die in their sin, and their blood will be on your hands. But if you warn the wicked and they refuse to turn, they'll still die in their sin, but you will have delivered your own soul. (Ez 3:17-19)

EZEKIEL 3

Sincerity-1 When non-Christians, who don't have Bibles, do naturally what the Bible teaches, they become living Bibles, showing God's will in their actions. Their clear consciences will back them up in this. (Rom 2:14-15)

ROMANS 2

Grace/obedience-5 You believe there is one God? Very good! But then the devils also believe this! (Jas 2:19)

JAMES 2

Sincerity-3 The King will say, "Come and inherit the kingdom; for I was hungry and you fed me..." The righteous will say, "When did we do that?" And the King will say, "Inasmuch as you have done it for one of the least of these my brothers, you have done it for me." (Mt 25:31-46)

MATTHEW 25

Sincerity-2 The Spirit of Christ lives in you, and you do not need any human teacher to tell you what is right or wrong. (I Jn 2:27)

I JOHN 2

Outreach-3 Don't say, "It'll be time to harvest in four months," I'm saying that if you look now, you'll see the fields are already overdue for harvesting. (Jn 4:35)

JOHN 4

Grace/obedience-6 Those who hear what God says aren't justified in his eyes; only those who do what he says. (Rom 2:13) Be doers of the word and not just hearers, or you just deceive yourselves. (Jas 1:22)

ROMANS 2, JAMES 1

Outreach-2 Preach the word. Do it instantly, whether it is convenient or not. Correct and challenge people patiently in all that you teach. (II Tim 4:2)

II TIMOTHY 4

Grace/obedience-7 To those who believe Christ, he is precious, but those who disobey him have left the most important stone out of their building. He offends those who balk at the truth, because they are disobedient. (I Pt 2:7-8)

I PETER 2

Sincerity-4 Anyone who receives you receives me; and anyone who receives me receives God. (Mt 10:40-41; Jn 13:20) All who know God accept the truth in what we say; all who do not know God refuse to listen. This is how we know the difference between a sincere spirit and a false one. (I Jn 4:6)

MATTHEW 10, JOHN 13, I JOHN 4

Outreach-4 The harvest is very big, but the workers are few. Pray that God will send workers to bring in his harvest. (Lk 10:2)

LUKE 10

Grace/obedience-8 Anyone who believes on the Son has everlasting life; and anyone who refuses to believe (obey IN TEV) him will not see life; instead, God's anger rests on that person. (Jn 3:36)

JOHN 3

Outreach-5 Do not let yourselves grow tired of doing good; for eventually we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. (Gal 6:9)

GALATIANS 6

Sincerity-5 True Jews are circumcised spiritually, in their thinking and attitudes. God looks for this, and not for the recognition of their fellow Jews. (Rom 2:29)

ROMANS 2

Sincerity-6 Don't you know that the real children of Abraham are all those people who have sincere faith? (Gal 3:7)

GALATIANS 3

False teachers-2 I order you on behalf of Christ to stay away from disobedient Christians. I've heard there are busybodies in your fellowship who refuse to obey Christ or work for God. (II Thess 3:6, 11)

II THESSALONIANS 3

Sincerity-9 As newborn babies, desire the sincere milk of the word, so that you can grow by it. If you do, you will taste the grace of God. (I Pt 2:2-3)

I PETER 2

Sincerity-7 Love one another, because love is from God, and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. Anyone who doesn't love, doesn't know God, because God is love. (I Jn 4:7-8)

I JOHN 4

False teachers-1 Note those who cause divisions and fight against the teachings of Christ, and avoid them. For they serve their emotions and not Christ. Through clever talk they deceive gullible people. (Rom 16:17-18)

ROMANS 16

Sincerity-10 To the pure, all things are pure; but to those who are defiled and unbelieving, nothing is pure; even their minds and consciences are defiled. (Titus 1:15)

TITUS 1

Rich/poor-4 Blessings on the poor, because the kingdom of God belongs to you... But curses on the rich, because you have already received your comforts. (Lk 6:20-26)

LUKE 6

Grace/obedience-11 People who fight Christ's teachings don't have God. People who obey him have both God & Jesus. (II Jn 9) True love for others only comes if we love and obey God. (I Jn 5:3) If you love me, obey me. Those who obey me are the ones who really love me. (Jn 14:15, 21, 23)

II JOHN, I JOHN 5, JOHN 14

False teachers-9 Some teachers claim to know God, but their actions deny his authority; they are disgustingly disobedient and opposed to doing good works. (Titus 1:16)

TITUS 1

Rich/poor-2 Let the poor be happy because he is being lifted up, but tell the rich that they will be made low, and they will pass away like flowers on grass. (Jas 1:9-11)

JAMES 1

Sincerity-8 All of the Bible is summed up in one rule: Love your neighbour as you love yourself. (Gal 5:14) The first and greatest rule is to love God with all your heart; the second is like it: love your neighbour as you love yourself. All the Bible is summed up in these two rules. (Mt 22:37-40)

GALATIANS 5, MATTHEW 22

Rich/poor-5 How difficult it is for rich people to enter the kingdom of God. It's easier for a camel to go through a needle's eye than for a rich person to enter God's kingdom. (Lk 18:24-25)

LUKE 18

Grace/obedience-1 Not everyone obeys the gospel. Isaiah said, "Lord, who has believed our report?" (Rom 10:16) If judgment starts with us, what will be the end of those who disobey the gospel? (I Pt 4:17)

ROMANS 10, I PETER 4

Rich/poor-1 Watch out you rich people! Cry for the miseries that'll come on you. Your wealth is rotten and moth-eaten. Its rust is a witness against you and will eat your flesh like fire. You've piled riches up for the last days. (Jas 5:1-3)

JAMES 5

Rich/poor-6 We brought nothing into this world and it is certain we can carry nothing out. So be content with food and clothing. Those who want more fall into temptation and a trap. (I Tim 6:7-9)

I TIMOTHY 6

Rich/poor-3 Hasn't God chosen the poor, who are rich in faith, to inherit his kingdom? Don't rich people persecute you and report you to the police. Don't they blaspheme the name of Christ? (Jas 2:5-7)

JAMES 2

Rich/poor-10 Don't save up wealth where moths and rust and thieves can destroy it. Save wealth in heaven instead. (Mt 6:19-20) Sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will be providing wealth for yourselves in heaven. (Lk 12:33)

MATTHEW 6, LUKE 12

Rich/poor-7 If anyone teaches otherwise, and doesn't accept the teachings of Christ, that person is proud, assuming that wealth is proof of spirituality. Withdraw yourself from such people. (I Tim 6:3-5)

I TIMOTHY 6

Endtime-10 That day should not overtake you as a thief. You are the children of light. So don't sleep as others do, but watch and be sober. (I Thess 5:4-6)

I THESSALONIANS 5

Rich/poor-9 When I return it'll be like Noah's day. They ate, drank, and got married till the flood destroyed them all. It'll be like Lot's time. They ate & drank, bought & sold, planted & built until fire fell from heaven and destroyed them all. (Lk 17:26-29; Mt 24:38)

LUKE 17, MATTHEW 24

Rich/poor-8 Undisciplined, proud teachers deceive people. They must be stopped, because they destroy whole families by teaching things they shouldn't, and all for the purpose of making money. (Titus 1:10-11)

TITUS 1

False teachers-3 Don't talk behind the backs of your leaders. Some people did this in the Bible and were destroyed. (I Cor 10:10) (Read about it in Heb 3:8-11 & II Tim 3:8)

I CORINTHIANS 10

False teachers-10 Our teaching was never deceitful. You and God know we didn't flatter you in order to get your money, or to be praised by you. (I Thess 2:3-6)

I THESSALONIANS 2

False teachers-5 Don't waste your time on people who still fight the truth after you've given them a first and second warning. (Titus 3:10)

TITUS 3

False teachers-4 Avoid foolish questions and arguments about ancestors and religious rituals. They accomplish nothing. (Titus 3:9) Avoid foolish questions, because they only lead to arguments. (II Tim 2:23)

TITUS 3, II TIMOTHY 2

False teachers-6 Don't trust every spirit you hear. Test them to see if they are from God. This is how to do it: Every spirit that acknowledges that Christ was a real person, and fully human is from God. (I Jn 4:1-2)

I JOHN 4

False teachers-7 If we would judge ourselves, we would not have to be judged by others. (I Cor 11:31)

I CORINTHIANS 11

Jesus>Bible-1 Jesus said, "For the hardness of your hearts Moses wrote this rule for you" (not because it was the eternal will of God). (Mk 10:3-5; Mt 19:8))

MARK 10, MATTHEW 19

Jesus>Bible-2 I'm saying this, not the Lord... I have no command from God, but I'll give my personal opinion. (I Cor 7:12, 25) What I am saying has not come from God, but is just my own foolish boasting. (II Cor 11:17)

I CORINTHIANS 7 II CORINTHIANS 11

False teachers-8 It is time for judgment to start at the house of God. And if it starts with us, what will be the end for those who have disobeyed the gospel? (I Pt 4:17)

I PETER 4

Bits of wisdom-2 Everything turns into something good for those who love God and want to do his will. (Rom 8:28)

ROMANS 8

Jesus>Bible-3 (of Jesus) His clothes were dipped in blood, and his name is The Word of God. (Rev 19:3) The Word made the world in the beginning, then became human and lived with us. (Jn 1:1, 14)

REVELATION 19 JOHN 1

Baptism-6 Christ sent me not to baptise, but to preach the gospel. (I Cor 1:7)

I CORINTHIANS 1

Baptism-4 There is only one Lord, one faith, and one baptism.

EPHESIANS 4

Health/healing-5 Evil people want miracles. But none will be given. Jonah preached to Nineveh, and Solomon preached to the Queen of Sheba. If truth alone was good enough for them, then it should be good enough for you. (Lk 11:29-32; Mt 12:39, 16:4)

LUKE 11, MATTHEW 12, 16

Baptism-1 John said, "I baptise with water, but one who is greater than me will come, and he will baptise with the Holy Spirit and (or?) with fire. (Lk 3:16; Mt 3:11; Mk 1:8))

MATTHEW 3, MARK 1, LUKE 3

Health/healing-2 What goes into your mouth does not determine if you are evil; but what comes out, from your thoughts and feelings, determines if you are evil. (Mt 15:11-20, Mk 7:18)

MATTHEW 15, MARK 7

Health/healing-3 Eat what is given to you, without asking questions of conscience. (I Cor 10:27) Anything is legal, but I do not want to be controlled by desires. Stomachs are for food and food is for stomachs, but both are temporary, not eternal. (I Cor 6:12-13)

I CORINTHIANS 6, 10

Health/healing-6 You do not receive because you do not ask; and when you ask, you ask incorrectly, wanting only selfish gifts. (Jas 4:3)

JAMES 4

Health/healing-1 (God told Peter to eat 'unclean' animals and he said he had never eaten anything unclean.) "What God has made clean, do not call dirty." (Acts 10:9-17, 11:5-10)

ACTS 10 & 11

Health/healing-4 Even those of us who have God's Spirit still suffer as we wait for our 'adoption', that is, the time when our physical bodies will be redeemed. (Rom 8:23)

ROMANS 8

Bits of wisdom-1 It's okay to be angry, but don't let it turn into sin. Settle grievances the same day that they arise. (Eph 4:26)

EPHESIANS 4

Bits of wisdom-3 A double-minded person is unstable in everything that he or she does. (Jas 1:8)

JAMES 1

Love-2 Let's not love just in words, but let us show true love through our actions. (I Jn 3:18)

I JOHN 3
